Description of the match:

The match was played in Donetsk, Ukraine under good weather conditions and in a stadium full of enthusiastic Spectators. With Shaktar already guaranteeing the next round, it was Juventus who needed to play harder and Push all they had. They needed at least 1 point from this match and at the end they got all three possible points With a controversial goal.



Referee

Comments:

The referee generally had an average foul recognition however he sometimes doesn't see players just leaving themselves to the ground. He called two very easy fouls on the same player as he just threw himself. Overall, good advantage application with staying close to the play. But he should see the players' intents and whether they are faking a foul or just falling down.

Minute	Description of the situation
7 th	A correct yellow card issued to Arturo Vidal after he committed a tactical foul.
21 st	Another yellow card for Shaktar this time, as the player came in cleats up. The referee considered this as reckless play and issued a caution. He could have gotten away by warning but he chose the yellow.
21 st	After the freekick was crossed inside the penalty area, the ball hit Fernandinho's hand, inside Shaktar's penalty area. As this was an unintentional move and his hand was in natural position, I agree with the referee by saying no penalty.
37 th	A yellow card for Kucher for Shaktar. The player had the ball dribbling and when Juventus player got the ball, he just swung his leg to him after the position. Replay showed it was a correct call.
72 nd	The referee issued a yellow card for a dive for Shaktar, 22. From the camera it looked like with a small touch from behind the player just let himself down. The referee was sure about the dive and immediately issued yellow. But again, card mechanics aren't that good. The player is still on the ground and there are 5 more players around the referee and he was holding the card up in the air.
87 th	A yellow card for Chiellini, Juventus. Too easy to my mind.

II. Tactical approach and its Degree of Consistency, Personality, Match Control and Management of the Teams and Players with special reference to the situations and the minutes when they occurred.

Comments:

Referee was generally consistent through the game but he sometimes didn't seem to be calling same fouls. His strategy was to card the players who were playing hard. Instead of talking to them, or warning them at first, he immediately chose to give out yellows. This strategy seemed to be working for him for this match.
